

1.1	Apologies were received from Iain McNay and Moorad Choudhry.

2.1	DH reported that he had received comments from MD and JL. ES said that he had sent some minor comments. At 2.1, the time limit for a judicial review application by objectors should be six weeks not six months. DH to circulate final version to be agreed by email and then published.	DH

DTB members to send any comments back to DH using track changes within a further 7 days, without copying their individual comments to other members. DH to circulate final version incorporating comments made within a further 7 days, having distilled any disparities between the various comments and proposed redactions where necessary. DG said that he felt it should be possible to for each phase to be turned round in 3 days. The aim is to finalise the minutes and put them up on the website within 3 weeks of each meeting. It was recognised that this is a very tight timetable and those concerned should put their hands up if unforeseen events mean that they cannot meet the deadlines so that others may intervene. The fallback will be that at the latest the minutes would be finally approved at the next monthly board meeting.
